

To My fellow NCLRA Members,

This will probably be one of my shortest articles as the president of the NCLRA.

In 2016 we will be electing the President, Vice-President, and Secretary/Treasurer. Some more thoughts on Sportsman Goodyear

Once again, DMAA Sportsman Goodyear will be held at the NATS. This year it will be sponsored by the Dallas Model Aircraft Association.

(Of course, thank you to Melvin for sponsoring in in 2015.) If you have even a casual interest in the event, please take the time to **read the rules!** They are at dmaa-1902.org. Contrary to what Jim Bradley said in the last Torque Roll, the ASP/Magnum and the Fox 15BB are **NOT** the only legal engines. They are generally thought to be the most competitive choices, but they are not the only choices. **Any** plain bearing 15, schnuerle-ported or otherwise, may be used. This means the OS 15FP and LA, Thunder Tiger and Magnum 15 GP, Fox 15 baffle and plain bearing schnuerle, Enya 15 baffle and plain bearing schnuerle, Norvel Bigmig 15, and a host of other engines. Additionally, ball bearing engines may be used as long as they are **not** schnuerle ported. This would allow engines like the Supertigre G15 and G20-15, K&B 15RR series 64, and others.

When the Fox plain bearing schnuerle 15 was discontinued 30 plus years ago, the ball bearing version was allowed to take its place. This was the only exception to the rule until recently. With Fox quality being "variable", the event was becoming the

private domain of those who either lucked into a good engine or made the effort to get one to work. The ASP/Magnum 15 was introduced as an inexpensive, easily obtainable (at least they **were**), good starting alternative to the hit-or-miss Fox. The venturi size was chosen to achieve performance similar to the Fox. I think we achieved our goal.

Who needs an ASP S15A?

Hobbypartz has been sold out for ages, and Tower and Hobby People are both out of the Magnum XLS 15A. I even read somewhere that the engine is discontinued, but have found no confirmation of that. So....

I am considering buying a bunch of engines from AliExpress. It looks like I could sell them for \$60-\$65 each, plus shipping to you. Shipping to me is included in the cost of the engine. I am trying to get an idea of how many engines I could sell to know how many I should buy. If interested, send me an email (billbisch@hotmail.com). This is not a firm commitment, I am just looking for a ballpark number.
